## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q. How long is the show?

A. The show is approximately seventy-five minutes long.

Q. To what age group is the show geared?

A. This play is geared toward teenagers and adults.

Q. From where do your actors travel?

A. Most of the time, our actors travel from St. Louis, Missouri, where we are based. We have many scheduled tours throughout the year, and can possibly work your location into one of our tours.

Q. How big is the cast?

A. "Socrates Meets Jesus" is a four-person play, with some actors playing multiple parts.

Q. Who wrote the script?

A. The script was written by Kevin O'Brien, founder of Theater of the Word Incorporated. Kevin adapted the script from the book by Peter Kreeft.

Q. What is the cost and what are the set-up requirements?
